LDS Church History Deluxe Combination Tour

Palmyra/Kirtland & Nauvoo/Independence

July 15 - 23, 2010

Days One & Two – As you begin your journey near Palmyra, New York, you can sense the roots of the restoration as you enter the Sacred Grove. You will see the stained glass windows that replicate the grove and the first vision in the jewel-like Palmyra Temple and grasp the humble beginnings of the Prophet Joseph Smith as you visit the Smith homes. Other area highlights will be the Grandin Bookstore, where you will see where and how the first copies of the Book of Mormon were published. You will travel to the site of the Whitmer farm in Fayette, where the Church had its official organization, and stop at Alvin Smith’s grave and the Martin Harris farm. Nestled in the nearby hills of Palmyra is the celebrated religious Hill Cumorah Pageant, a highlight of any visit to upper New York. Overnight near Palmyra for two nights.

Days Three & Four – You will become aware of the massive beauty of the famous Niagara Falls when you take a boat tour aboard the *Maid of the Mist* and face the churning waters at the base of three wondrous water falls. You then will head toward Kirtland, Ohio, and visit the Kirtland Temple, the first temple completed by the modern Saints. The energetic and knowledgeable “Mr. Kirtland,” Karl Ricks Anderson, will prepare you to embrace Kirtland as you become immersed in the atmosphere of early life in Ohio with the rebuilt and restored Historic Kirtland. Some buildings are original, such as the Newell K. Whitney Store and Whitney Home, others—a sawmill, ashery and school, for example—show how the early town was organized and how its citizens made a living. At the John Johnson Farm close by in Hiram, you will stand on the steps where Joseph was dragged when he was tarred and feathered—but also the place where he bore powerful testimonies of the restored gospel. You will stand in the room where Joseph received some of the most illuminating sections of the Doctrine and Covenants. As a group, we will enjoy dinner together at an Amish Kitchen. Overnight near Kirtland for two nights.

Days Five, Six & Seven – Following an early morning flight to St. Louis (included), you will learn about the days leading to the martyrdom of Joseph and Hyrum Smith on the way to the solemn and sacred Carthage Jail. Nauvoo will give you many different opportunities at the Family History Center, Seventies Hall, the burial site of Joseph and Hyrum, the Red Brick Store, the Women’s Statue Garden, and the Cultural Hall. While in Nauvoo, we will stop at the seldom visited Pioneer Cemetery. We will also visit the Stone Quarry and the irrigation canal site where John Taylor bid farewell to his wife prior to his mission to England. As a group, we will enjoy dinner together at the famous Hotel Nauvoo. One evening we will attend the Nauvoo Pageant—A Tribute to the Prophet Joseph Smith. There will be plenty of free time for you to become acquainted with historic Nauvoo on your own.

Day Eight – As we leave Nauvoo we travel to the banks near Haun’s Mill, site of an infamous massacre of Mormon men and boys. Our next stop is Adam-ondi-Ahman, where we will overlook an expansive valley and ponder the great events, past and future, at this important location. We will overnight near Far West, where several revelations, including tithing, were received. We will also see the cornerstones for a temple, which were laid when the Church was suffering severe persecution.

Day Nine – Sense the despair of a dingy prison where Joseph Smith and his companions spend time at Liberty Jail. Missionaries share the history of the jail in the Visitors Center that sits atop the jail. Next we will visit many important sites in Independence: Community of Christ Temple, LDS Visitors Center and the Temple lot, where Joseph Smith dedicated the land for a great temple in the latter days. Our tour will end this afternoon at the Kansas City International Airport.
